## The New Improved Ely Bus Service

The New 9 X9 & 9B

Your local bus service for –

**Witchford Road – Norfolk  
Road – St John's Road**  
*(including Yorke Way,  
The Chase and Longfields)*

### Where can you catch it?

Use any of the bus stops marked on the street map alongside.

### What time does it run?

Service 9 runs on Mondays to Saturdays, leaving your stops at –

**0820, 1035, 1235, 1435, 1635**

No service on Sundays or Bank Holidays

### Where does it go?

Service 9 links you with the Princess of Wales Hospital (a 15 minute journey), Sainsbury's (27 minutes), City Centre (32 minutes), Tesco / Railway Station (57 minutes). All buses except the 0820 then run on to Cambridge City Centre (a 100 minute journey).

## **What time is the bus home?**

From *The Princess of Wales Hospital* catch the number 9 bus to Cambridge, leaving at **0958, 1200, 1400, or 1600**, and change at Market Street for the number 9 bus back to your stop.

From *Sainsbury's* there are direct buses to your stop at **1020, 1220, 1420 and 1620**. Remember to use the stop opposite the store, outside Bell Holt.

From *Market Street* there are direct buses to your stop at **1030, 1230, 1430 and 1630**. Use the stop opposite the Museum.

From *Tesco / Railway Station* there are direct buses to your stop at **1017, 1217, 1417 and 1617**.

From *Cambridge Drummer Street Bus Station* there are direct buses to your stop at **0925, 1125, 1325, 1525**.

## **How much does it cost?**

For all single journeys in Ely the fare is £1.80. A Townrider ticket gives you unlimited journeys in Ely on the same day and costs £3.00. The normal concessionary schemes are valid on this service.

### ***About the Ely Community Bus Partnership***

Service 9 is a commercial service provided without any form of subsidy by Stagecoach. The Community Bus Partnership has been formed by the City of Ely Council, East Cambridgeshire District Council, Cambridgeshire County Council and local residents to help promote the service and use of the bus in Ely. Our aim is to help the service establish itself as a permanent facility for Ely residents and to assist its expansion to meet the needs of a growing community.
